



# 2010 Bolton High School Baseball Booster Club's 7th Annual Hayes Kent Memorial Basketball Tournament Rules:

**NOTE: ANY RULES NOT COVERED BELOW - WE WILL DEFER TO THE TSSAA HIGH SCHOOL RULES FOR BASKETBALL.**

**GENERAL RULES:**

1. Overtimes- 2 minute overtime. 10U Boys Recreation and 10U Girls will shoot free throws (5 players on court at end of regulation.)
2. Halftime- 2 to 3 minutes in length. (Referee Discretion)
3. Five minute maximum warm up time.
4. All players foul out on the fifth (5) foul. (Technical is counted as a personal foul, also.)
5. Each team has 2 full timeouts and 3 30 second timeouts to be used at any time during the game.
6. Game time is forfeit time. A team must have 5 players to start a game.
7. The tournament directors, in their sole determination, reserve the right to forfeit any team from the tournament because of the behavior of fans, players or coaches that may be detrimental to the purposes of the tournament.
8. Earrings, necklaces, watches, rubber bands, hair balls, any metal object or any pierced body parts on either boys or girls are not permitted.
9. Age for tournament is determined by a players age as of 1/15/10.
10. 10 and under teams (boys and girls) will use 28.5 ball and play 5 minute quarters. 12 and under teams (boys and girls) will use 28.5 ball and play 6 minute quarters. 14 and under teams (girls) will use 28.5 ball and play 6 minute quarters. 14 and under teams (boys) will use regulation ball and play 6 minute quarters. 16 and under boys and 18 and under boys will use regulation ball and play 20 minute running halves (clock will stop last minute of first half and last three minutes of second half).
11. Pressing is allowed in competitive divisions the entire game. With 20 point lead, teams may pick up at half-court. With 30 point lead, teams must play defense inside the arc. Pressing is allowed in the recreation divisions the last two minutes of the game. With 20 point lead, recreation teams must play defense inside the arc. **NOTE: IN THE RECREATION DIVISION IF BOTH COACHES WANT TO PRESS THEY MAY, IF ONE COACH DOES NOT THE RECREATION RULES APPLY.**
12. 10 and under boys recreation teams and 10 and under girls will play on 8 1/2 foot goals.

**SPORTSMANSHIP:**

Is expected from Officials, players, coaches and fans at all times. The Head Official in charge will handle any rule misinterpretations (no judgement calls will be addressed).  
Coaches will be responsible for their own conduct, fans and team behavior. Razzing, heckling, chanting or making disparaging remarks towards opponents, in any manner is prohibited. Unruly spectators may result in their team's forfeiture of game.  
If a player or coach receives a technical for an UN-sportsmanship like conduct (example) Fighting, a flagrant foul, or a coach touches an official, etc. They will be ejected from the game and the rest of the tournament.

**LINE-UPS:**

Each head coach must prepare a starting line up for each game and it must be entered in the scorebook listing first and last names and numbers of ALL players. The game WILL NOT start until this is completed.  
All teams must have (5) players to start a game.  
If you do not have (5) players at the start of a game you will forfeit the game.

**AWARDS:**

Awards will be presented to the top two finishing teams in each age group. Individual Trophies will be awarded for 1st & 2nd place for age 8-18 and under. MVP Trophy will be awarded for each age group at Championship game.

**COACHES PASSES:**

Each team will receive two coaches passes.

**TOBACCO USE:**

Use of tobacco products is prohibited on all school property.

**FOOD / BEVERAGES:**

No personal coolers will be allowed into the gyms. Bolton Baseball Booster Club will have a concession with various items for sale.

**FINAL NOTE:**

Teams are expected to pick up all trash and debris in and around the bench area before departure from all games. Please urge your coaches, players, and fans to use all trash receptacles provided.
