Hayes played for the Bolton Wildcat Baseball team for three years. He was a junior at the time of his death. The Bolton Baseball Boosters Club continues to honor and keep Hayes' memory alive through various events each year, including our annual Martin Luther King, Jr. Weekend Basketball Tournament; Fall USSSA Baseball Tournament; and other events and activities. It is in the spirit of Hayes Kent's joy for life, spirit of competition, determination to succeed and his love and devotion for family and friends that this scholarship is awarded.

- United States citizen or permanent resident;
- Graduating Bolton High School Senior with two consecutive years as a Varsity level baseball player at Bolton;
- Minimum SAT of 1,000 or ACT of 21 and GPA of 3.0 at time of graduation;
- Entering or enrolled in a two or four year college or university (including community college);
- Outstanding character, leadership and community involvement;
- Submission of 500 word essay (typed/double-spaced) describing how your high school baseball experience has prepared you for college; and
- The award of this scholarship will **NOT** be based on financial need.
